Designed by Inigo Jones in 1631, with a well maintained and colourful outside space, we can provide a rarity in Central London; an attractive and discreet location.

Ideally located a short walk from Covent Garden, Charing Cross, and Leicester Sq Underground stations, St. Paul's is a perfect venue to attract your guests. Whether you entertain them in the quintessentially English garden, or the church's stunning interior, The Actors' Church is ideal for a variety of events.

Our Theatrical History

St Paul's links with the theatre industry go back hundreds of years. In 1662, following the Restoration of the Monarchy, Charles II licenced two so-called 'Patent Theatres'. Those Patent Theatres, were, and are, in our Parish: they are now the Royal Opera House and the Theatre Royal, Drury Lane. Nowadays, many more theatres are in our parish, and much of the industry regards St. Paul's as its spiritual home.

Plaques commemorating icons of the stage and screen such as Charlie Chaplin, Vivien Leigh, and Noel Coward, not to mention the incomparable Barbara Windsor (who even has her own pub sign!) attract visitors from all over the world, and the recently refurbished miniature theatre is the icing on the opening night cake.





The Nave

The Nave is the main space for events and entertaining, and can accommodate up to 100 guests seated, or 250 for standing events.



With its soaring, elegant dimensions, beautiful stained glass windows, and stunning architecture, this is the perfect area to host a corporate event. The pews can be configured in a variety of different ways, or removed completely, to suit your needs.
